The Vermont Department of Libraries has discontinued the subscription to HeritageQuest as of January 1, 2020. There are multiple reasons for this discontinuance, but most prominent is that better access to genealogical records is available through MyVermont.gov and FamilySearch. Both of these options are available for free to Vermonters.
