

# Access to Vermont's Ancestry.com and Newspapers.com

A treasure trove of online newspapers and ancestry information is available now for Vermonters at Newspapers.com and Ancestry.com. To gain access, you must first create a free MyVermont.gov account at

Once you have created the account, you MUST add your contact information and fill out your profile as indicated in the picture below:
